Millions may die of AIDS

Epidemic keeps ahead of scientific advances

PARIS — Five million to 10 million people worldwide have been infected by the virus believed to cause AIDS and 3.5 million of them may die in the next five years, the world's AIDS experts have concluded.

Although scientists have moved with unprecedented speed to understand the disease's causes and effects, they are still far from believing that the

The American researcher called human cell leukaemia virus Type III (HTLV III).
